Per printer's notes on work: "Keep watermelon vine as a shadow //Bleach out flower red purple/gray/pink//Bring up pattern in dress just a little//pattern edge and drypoint color work together//Need better Black//Tone needs to be like b[?ook?]-More red brown not towards yellow//Later proof with sugar lift watermelon vine added to scraped out background. Raw sienna color smudge applied to print by hand"
